- Disruption in trade (sanctions) and international production networks
- Trade and labour market outcomes
- Artificial intelligence, new technologies
- Environmental innovation and knowledge spillovers through trade
- Migration and democracy

We invite submissions of empirical and theoretical contributions that analyze the above and related topics with an emphasis on a policy perspective.
