

2ndst International Week - University of Florence November 5-9, 2018



Dear Colleagues,

the Department of Economics and Management of the University of Florence is pleased to announce its **2nd International Week**, which will be held **from the 5**th **to the 9**th **of November 2018**. It will be an opportunity for teachers to give visiting lectures at our university under the Erasmus+ Teaching & Staff Mobility Programme, where applicable.

Academics are welcome to propose lectures in a variety of topics (<u>please check the application form for a complete list of available topics</u>). The lectures are targeted at Master and PhD students. The teaching language is either English or Italian.

We will analyze the content of each proposal and confirm if we can find a receiving lecturer on our side.

There is no participation fee. However, participants should cover the cost of travel, accommodation and meals. Where applicable, the funding might be available from the Erasmus grant distributed by the **home university**. We invite candidates to check the availability of such funding with their home institution. Please note that the Erasmus+ programme requires visiting lecturers **from partner universities** to give at least 8 hours of lectures within the regular courses offered by the host university, some of which might be given under the form of research seminars.

To apply for the International Week, please complete the **application form** and send it by email to *international.relations@disei.unifi.it* together with your CV. Please note that you are required to indicate the course(s) – among those listed in the application form – that best match(es) your lecture(s).



This is how the application will unfold:

2nd International Week – Application procedure					
Step 1	You send us your application with the chosen topic(s). Due by July 16, 2018 .				
Step 2	We work to match your topic(s) with the available courses.				
Step 3	If we are successful, you will be accepted in our International Week. Please note that there might be cases in which the match is not possible; we will have no choice but to refuse your application.				
Step 4	Notification of acceptance to all candidates to be sent by August 10, 2018.				
Step 5	For those candidates who have been accepted to participate, it will be required to send the Mobility- and the Teacher-University Agreement
