Dear Colleagues,

the Department of Economics and Management of the University of Florence is pleased to announce its **8th International Week**, which will be held **from the 19th to the 23rd of October 2026**. It will be an opportunity for teachers to give visiting lectures at our university under the Erasmus+ Teaching & Staff Mobility Programme, where applicable.

Academics are welcome to propose lectures in a variety of subjects/topics ([check the application form for a complete list](#)). The lectures (minimum required: 4 hours) target either undergraduates or graduates. The teaching language is either English or Italian¹.

Further, to make the International Week as beneficial as possible, each participant will be required to present a paper/work in progress during a research seminar session. Presentation will take about 20-30 minutes, followed by Q&As.

¹ Please note that the event is meant to host only academics and not administrative staff members.



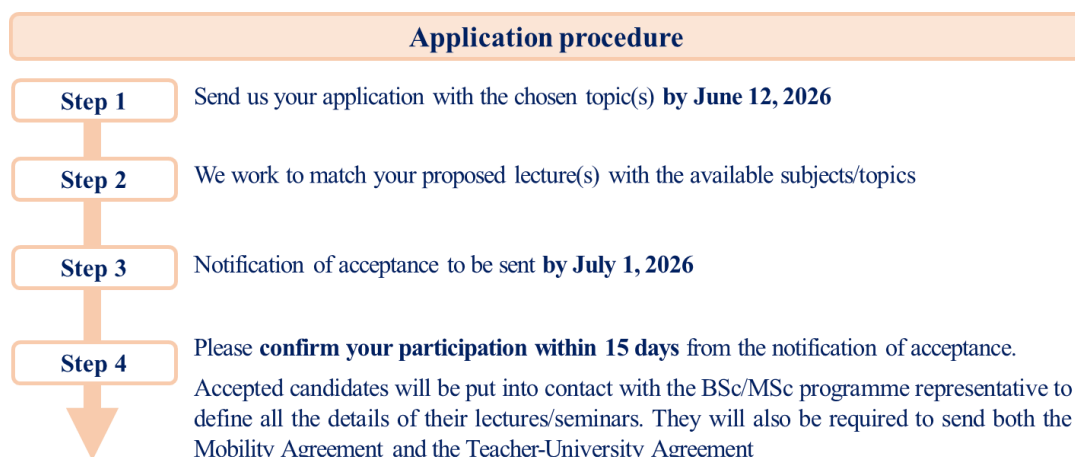
There is no participation fee. However, participants should cover the cost of travel, accommodation and meals. Where applicable, the funding might be available from the Erasmus grant distributed by the home university. We invite candidates to check the availability of such funding with their home institution. Please note that the Erasmus+ programme requires visiting lecturers to give at least 8 hours of lectures within the regular courses offered by the host university, some of which might be given under the form of research seminars.

- Deadline for application: **June 12, 2026**
- Notification of acceptance: **by July 1, 2026**
