Dear Colleagues,

the Department of Economics and Management of the University of Florence is pleased to announce its **4th International Week**, which will be held **from the 24th to the 28th of October 2022**. It will be an opportunity for teachers to give visiting lectures at our university under the Erasmus+ Teaching & Staff Mobility Programme, where applicable.

Academics are welcome to propose lectures in a variety of subjects/topics ([check the application form for a complete list](#)). The lectures (minimum required: 4 hours) target Graduates. The teaching language is either English or Italian.

Further, to make the International Week as beneficial as possible, each

participant will be required to present a paper/work in progress during a research seminar session. Presentation will take about 20-30 minutes, followed by Q&As.

There is no participation fee. However, participants should cover the cost of travel, accommodation and meals. Where applicable, the funding might be available from the Erasmus grant distributed by the home university. We invite candidates to check the availability of such funding with their home institution. Please note that the Erasmus+ programme requires visiting lecturers to give at least 8 hours



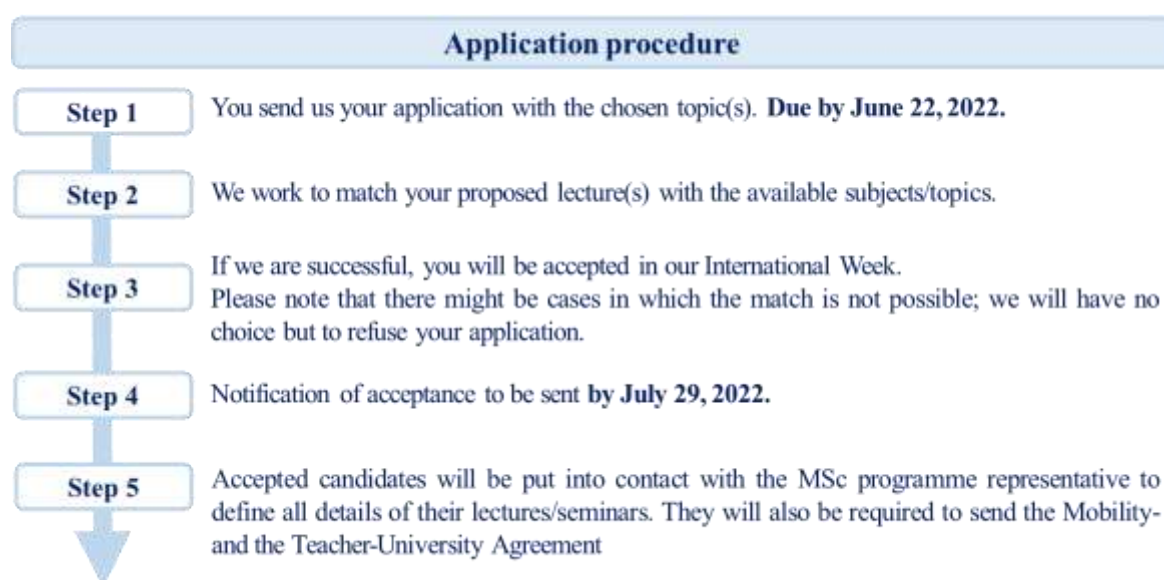
of lectures within the regular courses offered by the host university, some of which might be given under the form of research seminars.
