Monica Pratesi is full professor of Statistics at the University of Pisa. Her research focus is on improving statistics on poverty and living conditions both in relation to the integration with big data measures and the methodologies able to reach these extensions. She is director of the Tuscan Universities Research Centre – Camilo Dagum on Advanced Statistics for the Equitable and Sustainable Development – ASESD, a joint initiative of the University of Pisa, Florence and Siena. Scientific coordinator of several research projects on Small Area Statistics funded by the European Commission, She contributed to the birth and the consolidation of the InGRID research infrastructure, that wants to make an evidence-based contribution to a European policy strategy of inclusive growth. Since 2016 Monica is member of the Governing Board of the ISTAT and serves as a member of the Board of the European Master of Official Statistics of the European Statistical System. President of the International Association of Survey Statisticians of the International Statistical Institute (IASS-ISI) (2021-2023), she served as President elected of the Italian Statistical Society (2016-2020).

Monica is holder of the Jean Monnet Chair "Small Area Methods for Multidimensional Poverty and Living Conditions Indicators in EU" and member of the board of the Data Science PhD program at Scuola Normale Superiore in Pisa.
